In my estimation, sharing music with someone is one of the greatest gifts. Whether it is introducing someone to a new artist you like, getting a mixtape from a friend, pointing out something particularly cool in your favorite song, your brother-in-law giving you a pair of old drumsticks because he knows you like to play air drums, or singing at the top of your lungs with a friend while driving down the road. Music brings us together.

Growing up in Iowa, my mother filled our home with music. I don't think she realized the extent to which she was either singing or humming to herself, but it warmed our home. I shared a bedroom with my brother Grant growing up, and I remember him saving to buy stereo components. My life forever changed the moment he put his headphones on my head and played The Beatles for me. I never knew music could sound so good and it just filled my entire being. He took me shopping for my first album. Of course I didn't have a stereo, so I think I was just buying him another album for his collection, but the concept of having music I could listen to over and over again was thrilling to my little kid head.

I listened to Grant sing solos in the choir and thought nothing could be greater than that. I wanted to sing like him. His voice was clear and effortless. I have gotten the pleasure of singing with Grant only a handful of times, and they are cherished memories.

Then came the next big gift: twenty of Grant's favorite albums recorded onto ten cassette tapes for

me to listen to while driving. James Taylor, Kenny Loggins and James Ingram became my voice teachers. Then friends started recommending singers to me, something which continues to this day. Al Jarreau would change the way I looked at what a voice could do. It was inspiring listening to him use his voice as an instrument. And the happiness it brought him sharing his gift with others was infectious.

In college I met Jay R McAlexander and had the good fortune of him playing the piano with me while I sang a solo. I say "playing the piano with me" instead of accompanying me, or playing for me, because that is exactly what he did. He was with me breath for breath, emotion for emotion. It is a musical feeling I have chased my whole life.

Found in moments like singing the balcony scene from West Side Story with Christine Toy Johnson or with less than twenty-four hours notice going on for the lead in The Secret Garden in a theatre with over one thousand people in the audience and looking at McCrae Hardy conducting in the pit and everything about his gaze back at me saying, "We're in this together, so don't worry. I got you." To really "make music" with people is pretty rare, but it's truly an amazing feeling.

As a listener, it's an intangible thing you just feel. Great musicians, can play a song together and it sounds great, but it may feel like it's missing something. But when they connect and all those hours of practice become second nature and the emotion and joy of making music as a single unit comes through, you just feel it.



That was the goal of this album for me. To have fun and find the joy in making music with thoughtful, talented artists who invited the challenge of my crazy ideas about reimagining the singers and songs that have influenced me throughout my life. I was lucky to get to hang out with world class musicians from the Broadway and National Touring companies of COME FROM AWAY. These gifted cats took my ideas and never failed to come back with something better than I could have hoped for.

These songs all represent huge moments in the mosaic that is my life. I leaned into my Scottish roots and my love of acoustic live instruments and sounds, mixed it all together with R&B, Pop, Jazz, and Folk to create a unique Rockabilly/Bluegrass sound, and with the help of these great artists hopefully produced something that you enjoy because you hear that intangible connection I've felt "making music."
